Northwestern University Settlement House was founded in 1891 to help empower its neighbors in the West Town community to take personal responsibility for improving the quality of their lives and for overcoming the obstacles of poverty. These goals are accomplished through more than 70 programs. From young children all the way to senior citizens, this "rainbow of services" provides resources and guidance. Some examples include youth services that encompass after-school programs, a teen center, Head Start preschool classes, a new charter grammar school currently under development to open in August 2009, summer camp, and a theater production company that brings quality children's theater to thousands of Chicago's youth. The Settlement House also offers programs that reach families and adults which include computer classes, English as a Second Language, a Golden Agers Program, an art gallery, and emergency services such as a food pantry.
